

MISSION

"We believe in the healing power of learning and community. Our goal is to ensure that all children with a long-term medical condition have access to education that best suits their physical health and mental state, and that they can connect to supportive communities."

Each year several thousand schoolchildren miss school in Hungary due to their long-term illnesses. They are often completely isolated from their peers and have to cope with their academic requirements by themselves. Their inpatient treatment and the rehabilitation that follows can take months, or even years. At HospiEdu we work with secondary school and university students who volunteer to help them study and help them stay connected to their peer communities even during their absence from school. Over the past 8 academic years, our program helped more than 1,000 schoolchildren, with the support of more than 2,500 volunteers from secondary schools and universities. Our aim is to ensure that schoolchildren return to their everyday lives strong in spirit. We help these schoolchildren, their families and their schools throughout the process.

THE LEVEL OF THE IMPACT OF HOSPIEDU



We started with 4 kids and 20 volunteers, we now work with approximately 400 young volunteers who help 250 children every academic year. We have increased our initial reach in the capital to nationwide. Beside ensuring access to education we provide a community for children. It has a positive effect not only on them but on their families and our peer-volunteers, too.

Our vision is to establish a national network and in addition to teaching schoolchildren provide effective support in the field to stakeholders.

Through knowledge sharing, professional materials and trainings we could be more effective.

We have HospiEdu courses at 7 universities in Hungary, and our volunteers receive university credits for their work which is compulsory for them to get their diploma. We have developed our HospiEdu scheme which can be modeled for others. And we are working on the sectoral cooperation between the healthcare and the edu-cation system.

We are members of a ministerial working group, as a result legislative amendments have been made: After successful lobbying we arrived at the alteration of the respective legal re-gulations. This included that in 2022 we created the official definition of the criteria of a child with long term illness. We worked together to prepare and help develop the national professional gu-ideline on the education of children with long term illnesses. It is a milestone in Hungarian public education.

Thanks to the professional and communication activities of our foundation we achieved visibility for children with medical needs. Now the social awareness of the topic is noticeably increasing



WHAT IS THE KEY TO THE SUCCESS OF HOSPIEDU?

It is a non-profit organization organized from the bottom up, professionally and financially completely independent.

Our principle is that everybody who is involved including all the volunteers wins something in this cooperation.

Our strength is that we give personal attention not only to the kids with illnesses but also to the volunteers. This way we also make an impact on the future teacher community and we increase awareness about long term sickness.
